

The Center for Arts and Wellness invites families and friends, children and adults, to our first annual Halloween Scavenger Hunt, with social distancing! Participants can enjoy the thrills of the holiday by going on an adventure around town.

Participants in groups of 2 to 6 can go on a 1.5-hour adventure in their cars and search for objects in their neighborhoods to earn points and compete for prizes. Teams are asked to take photos of the objects with a member of their Team in each photo and post them on the Center's Facebook Event page. Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 highest scoring teams, best team name, and best decorated car.

All teams are asked to adhere to state laws and COVID-19 advisories including social distancing and wearing masks whenever necessary.

RULES & Frequently Asked Questions

1. The event will be held on Saturday, October 31, 2020, between 3.30 – 5 pm EST

- a. All participants irrespective of the location will start the game at the same time.
- b. Example: If someone is joining from the west coast, they would play the game between 12.30 2 pm PST.

2. Registration:

- a. Participants will register on the <u>CAW event website</u> as a team, fill a <u>google</u> <u>form</u> and <u>pay</u> an entry fee of \$15/Team in advance (by Friday, October 30).
- b. Each team should have a team name.
- c. Each team should have a minimum of 2 participants and a maximum of 6 participants of any age group.
- d. Registration fee / team \$15

3. Scavenger Photo Hunt:

- a. On 31 October, 2020, at 3.25 pm EST all teams will be sent a list of scavenger hunt items via the registered email.
- b. Teams will find as many scavenger hunt items for 1.5 hours and take pictures of them.
- c. At least one team member should be in each photo. This is to ensure that teams are not uploading pictures directly off the internet.

4. Upload Photos:

- a. A 2020 Halloween Scavenger Hunt Event Page will be created on the Center for Arts and Wellness's Facebook page. Click <u>here</u>.
- b. Post Team photo on Facebook:

On the day of the event, each team should upload a team photo as a post on the Facebook Event page, clearly showing all the participants. **The photo(s)** should be posted under the "Discussions" tab on the event page.

- c. Teams should also indicate their team name while uploading the Team photo.
- d. All teams should upload their team name and team photo on Facebook at least <u>45 min</u> before the start time of the event.
- e. Participants will upload pictures of Scavenger Hunt items <u>ONLY</u> in the <u>comments section</u> of their Team photo on Facebook. This will ensure that all photos associated with a Team are in one place and help the event admin in tallying the final Team points.
- f. Teams will also upload a picture of their car adorned with Halloween decorations in the comments section of their Team photo. The picture of the car should be uploaded during the time of the event i.e. between 3.30 5 pm EST on 31 October, 2020.

5. Basic Requirements:

- a. Phone with camera.
- b. At least one person in the team should have a Facebook account and join the CAW Event page.
- c. Car to travel while taking pictures.

6. Items to Find and Riddles to Solve:

- a. Teams will be asked to find Halloween or Fall themed items.
- b. Some questions may be riddle-based. Teams will be asked to solve the riddle and take a photo of that item and upload on Facebook.

7. Points:

- a. Each scavenger hunt item will be associated with points.
- b. Teams uploading a picture of their decorated car will be awarded +10 points. There is also a prize for the best decorated car.
- c. Points will be tallied at the end of the event.
- d. Photos shared only between 3.30 to 5 pm EST will be counted. Time timestamps will be checked.
- e. At the end of the event, the team with the maximum points will be the winner.

8. Social distancing guidelines:

- a. Participants must follow social distancing guidelines while playing this game.
- b. Please wear masks and carry sanitizers or other items as required.
- **9.** The Center for Arts and Wellness will resolve issues in case of any conflicts and will retain the final word in terms of eligibility, prizes or other matters.

10. Prizes:

Prizes will be announced by no later than November 4, and will be given to,

- 1. First, Second and Third team with the highest points
- 2. Team with the *Best Team Name*
- 3. Team with the Best Dressed Team
